What are the hazards?

COVID-19

Who might be harmed and how?

Body Piercers, shop staff (when present) and students (when present)

What I am already doing to control the risks?

Restricting access to one client at a time with no additional people allowed in the piercing room .

Allowing extra time between appointments for thorough cleaning and sanitising of all equipment.

Appointments only, no walk-ins.

Face shield, face covering, gloves, and all PPE worn at all times.

Ensure social distancing guidance is visible to all who enter.

Ensure the correct placement of chairs and equipment to allow social distancing for staff and clients.

Staff and students to undertake regular lateral flow tests.

This information has been made available via the website and social media as well as in the studio. Infographocs also available

Check the client isn't feeling unwell and doesn't have a raised temperature on arrival. Additional questions have been added to the standard consent form which is filled in by the client and submitted electronically prior to their appointment.

What further action do I need to take to control the risks?

None at present.

COVID-19

Who might be harmed and how?

Clients and visitors

What I am already doing to control the risks?

Ensure staff wear a face shield in addition to standard PPE.

Ensure all equipment and surfaces are sterilized prior to the client arriving as per standard procedure.

Instruct all clients to arrive at the time of the appointment, not early or late.

Walk-in clients will not be accepted until such time as relevant restrictions are lifted

Clients are not to bring friends or family along for the appointment.

Encourage all clients to wear a face covering unless exempt. Covering can be removed in the piercing studio if needed

Staff and students are taking regular Lateral Flow tests.

What further action do I need to take to control the risks?

None at present.
